

Questions to assess your child

These questions are useful to help you to better assess your child's talent(s) and performance(s):

Answer these questions as best as you can and take notes in order to use them later when consulting teachers and experts.

Does your child do their homework easily and independently?

Do you have to help your child doing their homework?

Is learning easy for your child?

Is your child able to comprehend quickly and remember contents?

Does your child love going to school??

Is your child able to independently organize their school materials? Does your child keep their schoolbag mainly tidy and organized?

Is your child a good student?

Does your child need to be instructed when learning? Is your child largely independent and does it in most cases know how to solve issues and exercises?

Does your child have a talent for languages and does it pick up a new language quickly?

Idoes your child have a particular interest for scientific courses such as mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology and informatics?

O Die Hauptschule

Students attending the Hauptschule get a leaving certificate when they complete Year 9 or Year 10. Students with good performances can also get a 'intermediate' leaving certificate called FOR that includes qualification notes for Sekundarstufe II (secondary school II). Students attending the Hauptschule will be prepared to go into vocational training. This type of school intensely helps students to choose a career by completing various short courses of practical training. A 'work studies' course starting in Year 7 introduces the students to the world of work and different parts of working life. Students are also given the chance to go to a Berufskolleg (technical college) to acquire an advanced leaving certificate and basic professional knowledge.

02 Die Realschule

Students attending the Realschule (Year 5 to 10) get an intermediate leaving certificate called FOR (Fachoberschulreife) when completing Year 10. Students learn at both an equal practical and theoretical level.

Every Realschule in Muelheim focusses partly on the so-called MINT courses (mathematics, informatics, natural sciences and technology) or on bilingual teaching. Students will be prepared for different vocational fields by offering courses of practical training and information sessions. The intermediate leaving certificate (FOR) qualifies its holder to apply for a vocational training course in different vocational fields. Students obtaining the intermediate leaving certificate with qualification notes (Fachoberschulreife mit Qualifikationsvermerk/FOR Q) qualify to attend Sekundarstufe II (secondary school II) at a Gesamtschule or Gymnasium.
